

# *Dullatur Lawn Tennis Club*

## **CODE OF CONDUCT: 2 April 09.**

- *It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their children are properly supervised at all times when they visit the courts to play.*
- *Members should show respect to other players and officials of the club. The club has a zero tolerance policy towards offensive language or aggressive behaviour directed against members of the club, guests or the Committee. Any member engaging in such behaviour risks having their membership withdrawn. Members are reminded that guests are their responsibility and need be made aware of the code of conduct.*
- *In busy periods when players are queuing, play must be limited. Members take priority over members with guests in time on court. Members may play for a maximum of 30 minutes before giving way to those waiting. Members playing with guests are allowed 20 minutes before giving way to others.*
- *Courts cannot be taken over for the purpose of long matches outside of the club's own tournament schedule.*
- *Absolutely no football strips or colours allowed.*
- *No chewing gum or food to be consumed on the courts.*
- *No litter to be left on courts.*
- *No bikes or scooters on courts.*
- *Gates must be locked after play unless other players are still on courts.*
- *Membership tags must be displayed on racket.*

**THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REQUEST ANY PLAYER IN BREACH OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT TO LEAVE THE COURTS AND WILL TAKE FURTHER ACTION AS NECESSARY.**
