Minutes Previously circulated, taken as read and approved.

Financial Report. We have insurance cover from Keegan & Pennykid Insurance Brokers for £490.67. K & P specialise in Tennis and Bowling Club Insurances. The policy covers £5,000,000.00 public liability, the courts and catch netting and storage hut and contents. It was suggested that a secondary account is set up for court maintenance.

Memberships..... We have had 6 enquiries for new memberships, four from Dullatur, two families from outside. We will lose two families due to relocation from the village. The membership for families stands at 31 in Dullatur 6 from outside.

Subscription Payments: The registration for coaching and subscription day for the start of the new season on Saturday 3rd May was a great success.
