Matters arising from Minutes..... Memberships & Coaching.

Financial Report.....A receipt book was purchased and receipts were given for Memberships and coaching. The second issue of £300.00 has been issued to pay the coaching fees. It was requested by the auditor George Inglis that a dated receipt is signed each week by the coach.

Memberships.....Letters and e-mail were sent to members who had not renewed this season's membership, offering them to renew by 31/7/07 or have their details removed from the files. We have several few family members and single junior members. To date 26 family memberships have been paid, 15 junior memberships have been paid. 8 families and 8 juniors have not responded we will still pursue the members as they may be on holiday.
