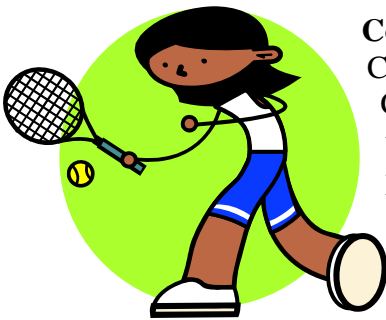


# Dullatur Lawn Tennis Club
